

SHOTGUN TRAP RANGE

Hours of operation: Saturday & Sunday: 8 am - 4 pm and Wednesdays 8 am – 11 am, but always check the website and calendar to make sure. Trap range may close earlier if there is no activity. To see if the shotgun range is open, call the Range (619) 468-3070.

Fees and charges: Day use fee for non-members is \$30 for all ranges, or \$10 for Trap range only. Each round of 25 Trap targets is \$8. Members can purchase a book of 20 Trap round tickets for \$140 (which works out to \$7 per round of 25).

Features: The Trap range is a SHADED 16-yard American trap range, 16 yard to 27-yard handicap. The trap machine is an electrically operated target launcher. A hand loaded mechanical spring trap machine is also available, however shooters must supply their own targets and shall be checked out by trap range officers prior to use. Trap participants shall provide their own shotgun (12 gauge or smaller) and ammunition (shot size 6 or smaller).

Trap shooting orientation and training can usually be offered after 9 or 10 a.m. (depending on regular trap activity).

As a free service to Club Members, on duty RO's will offer assistance and instruction in patterning of shotguns, (to learn as to where your shotgun is hitting),
